- Every year a different city
- Applications are evaluated by an Experts' Jury
- The winning city is selected by a Citizens' Jury
- Title-holding City will host a Democracy Year in close cooperation with civil society
- ECoD NRO bring key events to the Capital of Democracy
- Member Cities showcase existing and develop new democracy projects
- Civil society plays a crucial role



Dimensions of Democracy



Community

Community projects contribute to remarkable services, protecting the city's inhabitants from harm by future-oriented policies and long-term planning.



Empowerment

Empowerment projects enable the city to establish and maintain strong partnerships with civil society, academia and other relevant stakeholders.



Participation

Participation projects provide the city's inhabitants with access to a range of tools to become an active part in decision-making processes.



Sustainability

Sustainability projects aim to foster an international discourse, supporting citizens and other cities in ensuring that radical climate transformation is a democratic, and not just a technocratic process.



Technology

Rapidly developing technology will profoundly shape the future of democracy. The opportunities presented by digitisation are infinite and so are the challenges it poses.

Cities with Municipal elections between ECoD announcement & launch of Democracy Year (March '25 - January '26) undergo a risk assessment by the Experts' Jury and ECoD NPO.

1. APPLICATION - CALL SUBMISSION



2. ADMISSION TO THE NETWORK



3. EXPERTS' JURY - EVALUATION (SHORTLIST)



4. CITIZENS' JURY - SELECTION



Timeline for Cities to become European Capital of Democracy 2026!





Evaluation Criteria

- Collaboration: active partnership with other organisations, institutions and stakeholders
- Exchange: communication, dissemination and sharing of local initiatives
- Innovation: ambition and appeal of the programme and its main activities
- Organisation: management capacity, project and budget resources
- Output: planned activities and dissemination measures, how effectively target audiences, media and citizens are reached

These 5 evaluation criteria are assessed in comparison to the ambition and scope of the City's mission Statement.
