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What does Sociocracy mean?

... presented by Barbara Strauch

Democracy means rule by the people

while **Sociocracy** means governance by the associates.

We decide together - every voice matters

Everyone involved in an issue has a say and is given the space to speak in a forum in a constructive manner.

This requires strong principles and a clear structure.

A short history of Sociocracy





Auguste Comte created the word Sociocracy in 1853.

Kees Boeke first practiced consent in his school in 1926 and called it **Sociocracy**

Gerard Endenburg was student in Boeke's school and created the **Sociocratic Circle-organisation Method SCM** in 1970 in the Netherlands - shortly called **Sociocracy**



SCM - the Sociocratic Circle-organisation Method

This model for governance and self-organisation follows 4 basic principles:

- 1. Consent principle decision-making with consent
- 2. Circle principle semi-autonomous circles
- 3. Double linking always 2 people connect the circles
- 4. Open elections elect people for tasks and roles by consent





Consent principle decision-making by consent

The process led by the facilitator:

- 1. Picture-forming all questions for comprehension are answered
- 2. Opinion-forming 1st round for reactions, 2nd round for new learnings
- 3. Facilitator summarizes the proposal and asks for objections
- 4. Facilitator integrates objections



A decision is made when <u>no one in the team has a</u> <u>paramount objection</u> in sense of our common goal.



General Circle

Circle principle semi-autonomous circles as an organisational structure



Semi-autonomous teams have their jointly determined domain (decision-making area) and reach their aim self-organised.


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Double linking - always two people connect the circles



The circle-leader and the circle's delegate (representative) both are members of the two connected circles.





Open election - we select people for tasks and roles by consent

The election-process led by the facilitator



- 1. The circle clarifies the role with consent
- 2. Every member votes for a person and express the arguments
- 3. In a second round everybody can change their mind because of new arguments
- 4. The facilitator suggest for the most suitable person and ask for consent

- Common aim
- Logbook-System
- Helping-circles
- Development-talk
- Aim-realisation-process
- ... and more

Four roles in a circle

- 1. Circle-leader
- 2. Facilitator
- 3. Delegate / Representative
- 4. Secretary / Logbook-keeper

All tools are adapted to the specific needs of the organisation without leaving the principles.

All people are different and Sociocracy can deal with that well.





Qualities of sociocractic cooperation (1)

Diversity of Thought

- Embracing a wide range of perspectives. Finding common ground among differing views.

Power With - not Power Over

- Provide collaborative leadership rather than hierarchical control. Not creating winners and losers.

Common Aims

- Work together and focus on a common goals.

Inclusive Decision-Making

- Ensure that everyone's voice is heard. Find new answers / solutions together.

Empowerment

- Enable individuals to contribute meaningfully and have effect.

Transparency

- Provide clear and open processes and communication.



Qualities of sociocractic cooperation (2)

Effective Meetings

- Ensure everyone's input is valued and discussions are productive

Safe Spaces

- Create environments where everyone can express themselves without fear.

Building Trust

- Build stronger relationships and mutual confidence

Respectful and Appreciative Interaction

- Engage with one another in a way that honors each person's contributions.

Co-Responsibility

- Share the responsibility for outcomes and decisions.

Citizenship Competences

- Develop skills for active and informed participation.



Youth Council of the Municipality of Thermi GR Challenges, Learnings

- → Covid-19 & online meetings.
- → Municipality's projects, disbelief and low rates of attraction for new members.
- → Young people leave the place cause of studies, work, army etc.; thus, not many stay in the Council for long.
- → No circle structure now, participants work under General Assembly & are working on their new structure.

Soziokratie Youth Council of the Municipality of Thermi GR Impact

- -The first Youth Council in Europe to work with Sociocracy
- -Adoption of the Sociocratic Rules of Operation by the City Council
- -Networking & Participation in European Projects
- -Good practise!
- -New project in Municipal schools connecting school councils with YC
- -Innovator Council in Greece; meetings in Youth Forum















Process stages :

- Activation and issue/idea collection
- 2. Voting / prioritization
- **Public Neighborhood Forum**
- 4. Council Meetings 1 year cycle



WC

Within a one-year cycle, the elected council...

- works with the sociocractic principles, facilitated by the process-team
- is working together on the top-issues and objectives
- develops and publishes joint statements and positions to address issues
- address and seek cooperation with district-level politicians,
- city administration, or other actors
- start self-organized projects, take action
- … and more

Challenges and Learnings:

- Reach is still limited lot of effort to reach harder to reach groups.
- Funding is needed for sustainability.
- Cooperation and our good relations to district institutions and actors is very helpful.
- No use of Sociocracy in the low threshold stages of the process (1-3)



Meetings with city-admin and head of district More Trees in the area were planted Improved infrastructure for bikes Dialogue to moderate troubles with youth-groups Sonnwendviertel Festival

Benefits and Impact for society:

- Enabling effective citizen participation as an important complement to the representative democratic system at the local level.
- Create safe spaces for the exchange of opinions and ideas, forming a basis for transparent and fair decision-making processes.
- Opportunities to learn and practice political action, social competence, solidarity, values, and knowledge exchange.



Context

- Congress "Sociocracy & Politics", Salzburg, 2019 with pioneers of Indian children-& neighborhood parliaments
- EU-project Erasmus Plus "SoNeC" with 9 partner organizations of 7 European countries
- Case study "SoNeC " in Augsburg with support of City of Augsburg
- 1. SoNeC in Augsburg at (former) playground "Am Bogen", district Jakobervorstadt Nord





Actions 2021 until inauguration of playground, May 2023


- March 2021: Inviting 130 multicultural households "Am Bogen" for first SoNeC meeting in April 2021 - flyer & personal
- Small neighborhood circle (online meetings due to Covid) twice a month with sociocratic facilitation
- Outdoor-activities to get to know each other & community building (collecting garbage, flea market, planting campaigns ...)
- Regular meetings with district management and Green Office
 Department, City of Augsburg redesign of playground & green area

Challenges

- Covid 19 / online meeting during first months
- not everyone had access to PC & online meetings
- language barriers
- people were not used to address their neighbors
- SoNeC grew slowly only few neighbors with strong commitment
- "purpose" for SoNec weaker after inauguration of playground



Learning

Essentials:

- ressources: time, space, skills, funding for material and personal
- coordinators from neighborhood & district management as base for commitment and building of trust
- sociocratic coaching from the very beginning
- cooperation with municipality as (one) key to success and learning platform for political participation
- everyone wants to be seen & heard principle of equity



Impact

Partizipation & Empowerment

- Reshaping of playground / green area: planting edible & not edible plants
- Inauguration of new public playground: SoNeC as host, City of Augsburg as guest

Social Benefits

- Get to know one's neighbors
- Self organization & self efficacy
- Neighborhood help & inclusion
- Strengthening of responsibility







Next steps

In progress:

- 2nd. SoNeC "Am Lauterlech" neighborhood with mainly elderly people
- sociocratic facilitation of "District Working Group" & "Working Group Social Cohesion"

Utrechtse-Heuvelrug NL



- A beautiful countryside with 50,000 inhabitants living in 7 villages east of Utrecht
- Low population density and high average educational level
- 29 municipal councillors using socio-democratic decision-making since 2014
- 2006 Merger of five municipalities with considerable difficulties over many years
- Citizens acted as "Bridge-Builders" to support a political transformation process





BOB - Sociocratic consent decision making in a local council

Beeldvorming (picture forming) – councillors speak and citizens speak

Ordeelsvorming (opinion forming) - councillors speak and citizens watch

Besluitvorming (decision making) - councillors speak and citizens watch

Aims: well informed political representatives make better decisions and citizens participate in the most effective way (Information and Consultation during picture forming)

- The common aim consent on legislative program from all parties
- Involving citizens during picture forming and agenda setting
- Transferability in the NL and abroad


